# For UConn Storrs/Regional Employees who cannot telecommute due to their onsite job responsibilities

#### IF YOU DEVELOP COVID-19 RELATED SYMPTOMS, REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS:

#### **SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19**

• Fever or chills

Cough

- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Headache
- Sore throat

- Loss of taste or smell
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Complete a COVID-19 test kit request or obtain a test on your own.
- If you are at home, stay home and use your regular call-out procedures.
- If you are at work, continue to always wear your mask, and notify your supervisor so you can go home as soon as possible.
- Your manager may request your test results for payroll and return-to-work determinations. There is no need to report any test results to HR.

(Do not call the UConn Health COVID Call Center.)

#### **COVID-19 TEST RESULTS GUIDANCE**

#### If you test positive:

- 1. Isolate at home for at least 5 calendar days from time of symptom onset or positive test date if asymptomatic.
- 2. After 5 calendar days, you may return to work if you are vaccinated and/or boosted and have no fever or mild/improving symptoms. If you are unvaccinated, you must be symptom-free to return to work.
- 3. No additional test is required to return.
- 4. Follow heightened safety protocols for 10 calendar from onset of symptoms or positive test if asymptomatic

#### HEIGHTENED SAFETY PROTOCOLS:

- Always wear a mask.
- Avoid eating with others.
- Diligently monitor symptoms.

Your manager may ask you for your vaccination/booster status and/or any test results for payroll and return-to-work determinations. There is no need to report any test results to HR.

(**Do not call** the UConn Health COVID Call Center.)

#### If you test negative:

You may return to work when you have had no or significantly improved symptoms for at least 24 hours.

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#### If you have a known high-risk exposure to someone with COVID-19

(6 feet or closer to someone who is COVID Positive for 15 minutes or more while at least one person is unmasked)

#### If you are fullyvaccinated <u>and</u> boosted against COVID-19

(Received a COVID-19 booster shot at least 48 hours ago)

- 1. Continue reporting to work, if scheduled to do so.
- 2. For 14 calendar days, practice the heightened safety protocols below.

If you test positive or develop symptoms, follow the applicable guidelines on Page 1.

#### If you are fully-vaccinated, but not boosted against COVID-19

(Two weeks after second dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, or 2 weeks after one dose of J&J vaccine)

- 1. <u>Complete a COVID-19 test kit</u> <u>request</u> or obtain a test on your own. Take a test.
- 2. Continue working while awaiting your results, while following heightened safety protocols.
- If negative, report to campus, if scheduled to do so. Retest within 5-7 calendar days.
- 4. For 14 calendar days, practice the heightened safety protocols below.

If you test positive or develop symptoms, follow the applicable guidelines on Page 1.

#### If you are not fullyvaccinated against COVID-19

(Received one dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, or within two weeks of final dose of any vaccine, or unvaccinated)

- 1. <u>Complete a COVID-19 test kit</u> <u>request</u> or obtain a test on your own. Take a test.
- 2. Continue working while awaiting your results, while following heightened safety protocols below.
- If negative, report to campus, if scheduled to do so. Retest within 5-7 calendar days.
- 4. For 14 calendar days, practice the heightened safety protocols below.

If you test positive or develop symptoms, follow the applicable guidelines on Page 1.

#### If you have a CONTINUOUS high-risk exposure to someone with COVID-19

(employee cannot effectively quarantine from the COVID Positive individual, such as a dependent household member who has COVID-19 and cannot properly isolate)

#### If you are fully-vaccinated and boosted against COVID-19

(Received a COVID-19 booster shot at least 48 hours ago)

- 1. Complete a COVID-19 test kit request or obtain a test on your own. Take a test.
- 2. Continue working while awaiting your results, while following heightened safety protocols.
- 3. Re-test on calendar day 5.
- 4. If you test negative, continue to work.
- 5. For 14 calendar days, practice the heightened safety protocols below.

If you test positive or develop symptoms, follow the applicable guidelines on Page 1.

#### If you are fully-vaccinated, but not boosted against COVID-19

(Two weeks after second dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, or 2 weeks after one dose of J&J

vaccine)

- 1. Complete a COVID-19 test kit request or obtain a test on your own. Take a test.
- Continue working while awaiting your result, while following heightened safety protocols.
- 3. Re-test on calendar Day 5, Day 7 and Day 10.
- 4. If you test negative, continue to work.
- 5. For 14 calendar days, practice the heightened safety protocols below.

If you test positive or develop symptoms, follow the applicable guidelines on Page 1.

#### If you are not fully-vaccinated against COVID-19

(Received one dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine, or within two weeks of final dose of any vaccine, or Unvaccinated)

- 1. Complete a COVID-19 test kit request or obtain a test on your own. Take a test.
- 2. You must be away from your onsite work location for 5 calendar days from the date the COVID Positive contact's symptoms began or their positive COVID test.
- Re-test on calendar Day 5.
- 4. If your test is negative, you can return to work on calendar Day 6.
- Re-test again on calendar Days 10 and 15. (counting from the contact's symptom onset). If you test negative, continue to work.
- 6. For 19 calendar days, practice the heightened safety protocols below.

If you test positive or develop symptoms, follow the applicable guidelines on Page 1.
